Hello,

Thank You for choosing Keepsake Ash to create your Glass memorial.

If you're not comfortable gathering the Cremains and placing them in the plastic bag I suggest having a crematory do it for you.

We need about 1 teaspoon of cremains ash (powder form) returned in the provided small plastic zip lock bag. This is approximately two scoops from the provided wooden spoon. Place the small bag into the larger clear sealable plastic bag (seal the bag) and return it in the white bubble envelope provided.

We suggest using USPS (United States Postal Service) and follow these instructions. This is the only way you can ship human ashes through the postal service. At the counter, you should ask for Priority Mail Express envelope, if you're shipping it domestically, and Label 139, which is the Postal Service Cremated Remains label.

You will have to pay the postage to send us the ashes.
